This year, Global Ethics Day will take place on **October 21, 2026**, with the new theme “Re-centering Ethics.” Join us and use the power of ethics to build a better future!

Established by Carnegie Council in 2014, Global Ethics Day is an annual moment for individuals and organizations to explore their values and the principles that shape ethical decision-making.

Since then, citizens, businesses, professional organizations, schools, governments, and nonprofits from over 100 countries have planned activations to empower ethics.

Past participants have organized everything from full-day civic engagement workshops for municipal workforces to visual arts activities on values led by third-grade teachers, company town halls on emerging ethical challenges, and university watch parties for Carnegie Council’s Global Ethics Day keynote event.
